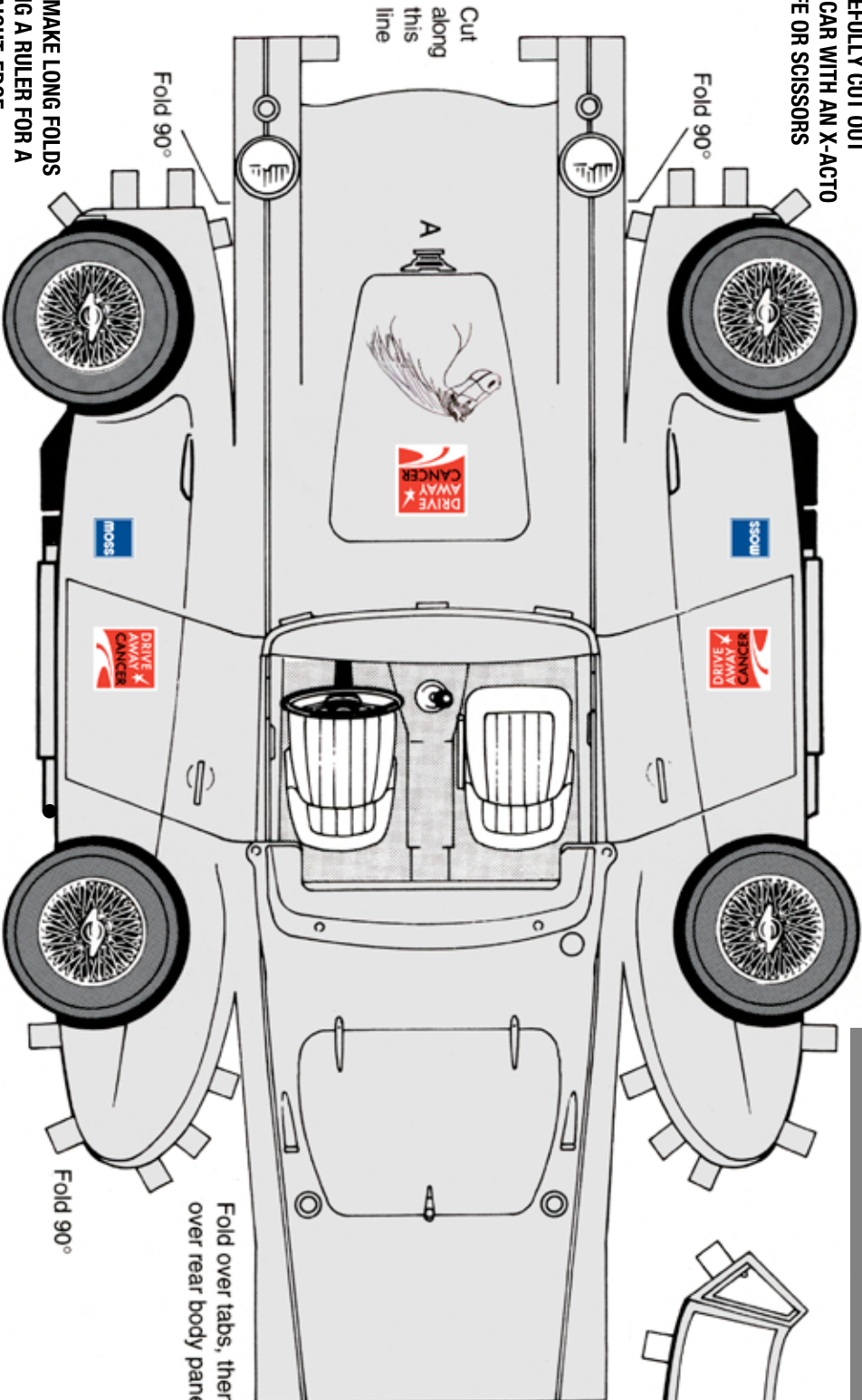
It is easier to color Grace before you cut her out. Felt tip markers or color pencils work great.

CAREFULLY CUT OUT THE CAR WITH AN X-ACTO KNIFE OR SCISSORS



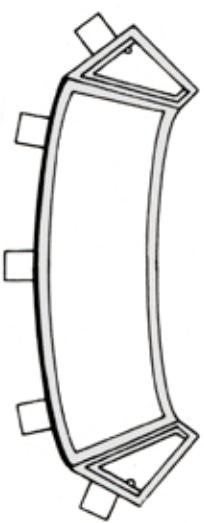
Fold 90°

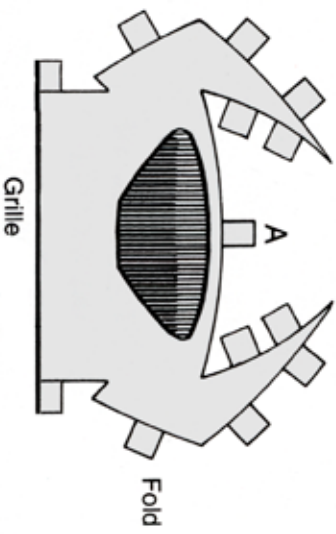
Fold over tabs, then roll over rear body panels.



LOCATE WINDSHIELD IN SLOTS ON COWL, CURVING IT TO MAKE IT FIT AND STAND.

TIP: TAPE COMPLETED MODEL TO CARDBOARD BASE. (BLACK OR DARK GRAY LOOKS GOOD.)

TIP: MAKE LONG FOLDS USING A RULER FOR A STRAIGHT-EDGE.



1. SIDE VIEW OF CUT-OUT GRILLE



2. FOLD INNER FENDERS 90° UP



3. FOLD GRILLE TOP TO MATCH CURVATURE OF HOOD.



4. FOLD FRONT AND TOP TABS OUT. FOLD BOTTOM TABS IN. NEXT, TAP/GLUE THE LOWEST TABS TO THE INSIDE OF THE WHEELS



5. WHEN YOU'RE FINISHED FOLDING, YOU SHOULD END UP WITH A PIECE THAT LOOKS LIKE THIS. FITTING THIS PART IS TRICKY! THE INNER FENDERS ARE A TIGHT FIT AND YOU MAY NOT NEED TO TAPE/GLUE ALL THE TABS.
